

RSA FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Request to show all RSA accepted offers going back to 1990.

Due to a change in our computer system, I am not able to provide figures going back as far as 1990. I can, however, supply you with details of the accepted offers of RSA for the 10 financial years between 1995/96 to 2004/05 (see table below).

You should note that, RSA is paid in instalments, typically over several years as job and capital expenditure targets are met. Not all projects proceed as planned, and not all accepted offers result in full payment, as projects are sometimes scaled down or abandoned before payments are made. The figures quoted in the table, therefore, represents the maximum grant potentially payable if the project is satisfactorily completed, and not the amount of grant actually paid.

I would also add that the figures in the table have been produced, today, from our live database and may differ slightly from those elsewhere on our website. This is because some offers will have been re-negotiated since the original acceptance was received.
